Eaglerock subsequently changed its mind, and decided that even redacted invoices could not be given, because they could identify the supplier by the type face. I don't think Eaglerock is trying to delay, they just have had several second thoughts.

My understanding for now is that Star Gas is pleased with the information they have received. In particular, the format of the financial projection, which includes the monthly actuals, in a very organized "peel back" fashion, makes their process much easier.

The quality of the data they are getting, which is everything they need except for the invoices, is giving them greater overall comfort, so perhaps they will not need to "audit" invoices at the level they originally thought.

We are cautiously optimistic that we will be able to satisfy them on the fuel invoice issue, although this may require the hiring of a third party under a confidentiality agreement, and is not yet resolved.
