OFFER OF EVIDENCE BEARING ON AIG'S PARTICIPATION IN THE PROPANE AND PETROLEUM GASES INDUSTRY IN FURTHER SUPPORT OF WILLIAM H. MALOOF'S OBJECTION TO DEBTORS' MOTION FOR AN ORDER APPROVING THE COMPROMISE OF CLAIMS AND TERMS OF SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND RELATED RELEASES OF WALTER HIMMELMAN, WILLIAM H. MALOOF AND THE NATIONAL UNION FIRE INSURANCE COMPANY OF PITTSBURGH, PA.

Now comes William H. Maloof, by and through counsel undersigned, and offers the following evidence bearing on AIG's participation in the propane and petroleum gases industry in further support of his Objection to the Motion Approving the Compromise and Settlement of Claims and Terms of Settlement Agreement and Related Releases of Walter H. Himmelman, William H. Maloof and National Union Fire Insurance Co. of Pittsburgh, PA.;

1.) Exhibit 1 is an order of the Department of Energy (DOE) granting AIG Energy Trading, Inc. Blanket Authorization to Import and Export Natural Gas to and from Canada and Mexico, dated January 23, 2003. Of particular relevance are the following statements by the DOE, first, that AIG Energy Trading "is in the business of purchasing and reselling natural gas;" second, that the authorization was for *500 Billion cubic feet* of natural gas over the succeeding two years; and third, that, through AIG Trading Group, Inc., AIG Energy is a wholly owned subsidiary of AIG International, Inc. This puts AIG squarely in the fossil fuel arena.

2.) Exhibit 2 is the January, 2008 EIA-782C Exclusionary List. The Exclusionary List is related to the EIA-782C survey, which attempts to measure petroleum product demand on the state level. The Exclusionary list was developed to avoid "double counting" by excluding "all

other company classes, including refiners, gas plants, operators, traders, large inter-state distributors, and exporters,” Instructions at Paragraph 1. On the list itself, AIG Trading is listed on page 1.

Both of these documents are demonstrative of AIG’s involvement in the petroleum products industry, which supports the argument as to the insurance policy advanced in the Objection to which these documents are offered in support.
