NOTICE OF FILING AN APPEAL FROM A BANKRUPTCY JUDGE'S DECISION

The parties are hereby notified that an Appeal from the order of the Bankruptcy Judge has been filed in the above entitled case.

In conformity with the Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the appellant shall serve and file his brief within **fifteen (15)** days after the entry of the appeal on the docket, pursuant to **Rule 8007**, unless otherwise ordered by the Court. The appellee shall serve and file his brief within **fifteen (15)** days after service of the brief of the appellant. The appellant may serve a reply brief within **ten (10)** days after service of the brief of the appellee.

Oral argument on appeals shall not be heard unless written application is made and the Court determines that oral argument would be beneficial in resolving the issues.

All briefs must be served on adverse parties.
